### What is "Maundy Thursday"?

March 28th is *Maundy Thursday* with a special communion service here at CPCC at **7:00 PM**. You could call it "Good Friday–Eve" the night before Jesus' betrayal and crucifixion. That evening Jesus gathered His disciples to eat the Passover meal, which we know as the Last Supper. Jesus used that bread and a cup of wine to institute Christian *Communion* (the Lord's Supper) giving His disciples a command to love one another ('maundy' comes from command, as in "mandate"). Plan to join us this Thursday at **7:00 PM**.
